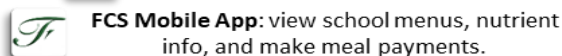
The Fulton County School Nutrition Program has participated in the National Farm to School Initiative since 2011, offering all students access to locally and regionally grown fresh produce!

Each month, the School Nutrition Program works closely with a produce distributor to find local or regional farmers to supply farm fresh fruits or vegetables to all school cafeterias! Since the beginning of the initiative, students have had access to farm fresh collard greens, cabbage, celery, kale, tomatoes, peppers, cucumbers, zucchini, yellow squash, apples, oranges, watermelon, strawberries, and more!

Fulton County Schools was recognized with the Golden Radish Award, a prestigious state-wide farm to school distinction which acknowledges the outstanding leadership of school representatives building comprehensive farm to school programs.

You have the option to pay with cash or check at your school cafe or to prepay online using MyPaymentsPlus. Families may qualify for free or reduced price meals. Applications are available in the cafe and available anytime online.

District Charge Policy: Elementary School Students will be allowed to charge breakfast and lunch meals for a maximum of three (3) days to their account after the balance reaches zero. Once a student has charged those three days, he/she will not be allowed to charge, however he/she will be offered a designated menu alternate. Extra sale items may not be charged. Middle and High School Students are not allowed to charge breakfast and lunch meals or extra sale items. For further information, see Operating Guideline JS – Payment for Meals and Meal Charges. Board policy and administrative procedure concerning fees must be consistent with state law and policy of the Georgia Board of Education.
